What is it?	<ul> <li>Graded word lists and reading passages with related recording forms that teachers can use to identify student's reading level and their reading strengths and needs.</li> <li>Contains a collection of early literacy assessments for young students as well as reading comprehension and competence assessments for older students.</li> </ul>
Type of administration	Individual
Grades	Pre K – 12
What does it measure?	<ul> <li>Early Literacy including letter knowledge, literacy knowledge, wordless picture reading, caption reading, auditory discrimination, phoneme awareness (spelling), phoneme segmentation, word knowledge</li> <li>Vocabulary: graded word lists</li> <li>Fluency: oral reading accuracy and fluency</li> <li>Comprehension: Oral reading comprehension, listening comprehension</li> </ul>
When can they be used?	<ul> <li>In the fall of the school year for students.</li> <li>As a progress monitoring instrument throughout the school year.</li> </ul>
Who can use it?	<ul> <li>Classroom teachers and reading specialists can use this inventory. This book includes the tools needed for the teacher to assess, interpret and develop responsive reading instruction for their students.</li> </ul>
