

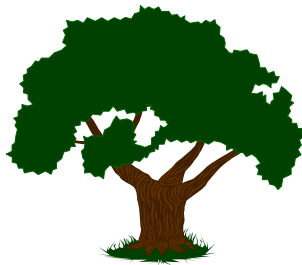
Issue Analysis
