

Using Visual Reminders



Visual reminders can provide students with a sense of security as they learn behavioural and social expectations. Visual reminders can be used to help students learn and follow:

- expectations
- strategies
- routines
- schedules

Visual reminders should be:

- posted in areas of the school that relate to expected behaviour.
- stated in positive language that describes the behaviour
- stated in student-friendly language that is simple and easy to understand.
- paired with visuals that illustrate or demonstrate the behaviour

It might be useful for some students to create a reminder on their laptop or ipod, or to tape a visual reminder on their desks or inside a binder to help them remember classroom routines, expectations and schedules.
