

Basic Styrofoam Glider

The Basic Styrofoam glider uses the tops of two standard Styrofoam egg cartons (dozen size). Trim off the top-sides of the cartons so you have two flap pieces of styrofoam. Follow the instructions carefully and using the template shown on page three cut out the pieces.




 Cut out the three templated shapes from the carton lids. Place the template directly on the styrofoam, glue it, and cut right through the paper and Styrofoam at the same time. Then, make the cuts and score lines (fold lines) indicated as noted on all three pieces. When scoring(folding), be sure to do so very gently or the flaps will break off.





2) Cut two holes in the fuselage as noted in the template.

- 3) Assemble the wing pieces with the flaps facing towards the rear.
- 4) Push the tail piece through the back of the fuselage (score lines up).



5) By placing and adjusting a paper clip to the nose of the glider, the added weight can affect the distance and stability of the flight.
